Update - A female posted a video at the accident on social media. <u>She stated</u> her son called her because the bus driver wouldn't stop the bus after hitting a car. Please note: the investigation is ongoing and has not been completed. She made many statements regarding the bus driver, Mr. Talley, and DPD. She recorded student faces, the bus driver, and the area.

When Mr. Talley arrived at the scene, he told individuals they needed an ID to remove kids to confirm they were the parent or parents of that particular student. The parent(s) who did not have IDs, he took a picture of him or her for safety reasons as they were removing kids. This upset this individual, and she began to make derogatory remarks towards Mr. Talley. She then recorded Mr. Talley and made more derogatory remarks towards him. The police were there when all of this unfolded. This individual made racist remarks towards the police and Mr. Talley as well. There were at least 2 students that you could hear that were clearly upset in the video. There were adults on the scene that were loud and using profanity around the kids. The video, on social media, was about 30 minutes in length, with a lot of profanity. One individual was also making threatening remarks towards Mr. Talley.

At this time, we are still waiting on the police, Alltown and the District to review the bus video and confirm what actually took place.
