The total amount assessed may be greater than the amount assessed on a guilty plea. Any cash bail or other security you have deposited will be applied toward payment. If you are an Illinois Driver and you fail to pay in full any judgments imposed, a notice will be sent to the Secretary of State and your driver's license will not be renewed, reissued, or reclassified, until full payment is received.
